YouGov/CO Covid-19 Public Attitude Research

Fieldwork: 17/03 to 18/03

Sample: 1,547 UK Adults. Data weighted to be nationally representative.

Summary of key stats relating to reduced/stopped activities:

- 45% report they have stopped, and 17% have reduced the amount they attend bars, pubs and restaurants.
- Around 40% have reduced the amount they visit family and 42% have reduced the amount they see friends who do not live with them.
- 27% have stopped seeing family, 30% have stopped seeing friends entirely.
- Just over a third (35%) of the public, and more than half (59%) of full-time workers are still going to work as often as before.
- 16% of those with school age children have already stopped their children going to school.
