The Inquiry will be held at Tockwith Village Hall, 1 Marston Road, York, YO26 7PR on Wednesday 02 December 2020 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by deleting the part of path no. 15/95/6 between Scallymoor Farm (SE 5340 5566) and Woodhouse Bridge (SE 5365 5570) and by adding path no. 15.95/11 from Scagglethorpe Lane (SE 5341 5566) running east on the southern side of the drainage ditch to Woodhouse Bridge (SE 5365 5570).

#### Within 8 weeks of the start date by [by 18 August 2020]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the

Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

#### Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 29 September 2020]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

#### 4 weeks before the date of the inquiry [by 03 November 2020]

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (including copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence);
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (including copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence); and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority, the applicant, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (including copies of any supporting

This Order is made by North Yorkshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to Section 54A, a byway open to all traffic and because it appears to that authority that the Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(iii) of the Act, namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. North Yorkshire County Council hereby order that:-

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 14 July 2014.
- The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "Public Footpaths 15.95/6 (Part) and 15.95/11, Moor Monkton Modification Order 2014".


