RE: Request for Information – RFI2978

Thank you for your recent email, which was processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). For clarification, you requested the following information:

- *The number of high rise buildings in England broken down by types of premises if possible (i.e. hospitals, purpose built flats (1-3 storeys, 4-5 storeys, 6-9 storeys, >=10 storeys), hotels, etc.)*
- *The number of high rise mixed use (commercial and residential) buildings in England*
- *The number of high rise residential buildings in England*
- *If possible, can the results be broken down by metropolitan counties/regions?*

Can I receive back this information in an excel type document, please? If you can also supply me with the UPRNs of these buildings that would be perfect.

Response

I am able to confirm that Homes England does not hold the information detailed in your request. This is because there is no legal or business reason for Homes England to do so.

In order to conclude that the information is not held, we have searched with our Land and Spatial Solutions teams who would have the requested information if held.

The FOIA does not oblige a public authority to create information to answer a request if the requested information is not held. The duty under section 1(1) is only to provide the recorded information held.
