- 1. Could you kindly clarify if the GLA are responsible for all grant funding in the Greater London area, for affordable housing, and if so, when they assumed this responsibility?
- 2. If your organisation holds any information about the following site (information I'm specifically looking to obtain includes which affordable housing program this site falls under, any grant based information that could have been provided to the developer (Fairview or Cricklewood Developments) or the landlord (Network Homes), any information that would relate to or impact on rent charged/funds obtained to develop the site. The address of the site could be listed under any of the following:

Development Site Between Formerly Known As Cricklewood Lane London NW2 2DP


Or

- 3. Please provide copies of any agreements your organisation holds with Network Homes, Fairview or Cricklewood Developments, either related to the above site or specifically related to affordable housing, in the London region, that started in 2016 and completed in 2019.
- 4. Should all affordable homes built with your grant funding have rents set that reflect and are based on market values (ie be a set percentage of market value across a particular scheme).

Response

Question 1

I am able to confirm that the Greater London Authority is responsible for the affordable homes programme and the allocation of grant funding under this programme within London, and has had this responsibility since April 2012.

Questions 2, 3 and 4

I am able to confirm that Homes England does not hold the information detailed in your request. This is because there is no legal or business reason for Homes England to do so, as detailed in our response to question 1.

In order to confirm that the information is not held, we have searched with our Affordable Housing team who would have the requested information if held.

The FOIA does not oblige a public authority to create information to answer a request if the requested information is not held. The duty under section 1(1) is only to provide the recorded information held.
