Construction noise and vibration Monthly Report – May 2020

London Borough of Camden

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Non-technical summary

This Noise and Vibration Monitoring Report fulfils HS2 Limited's commitment detailed in the Environmental Minimum Requirements (EMRs), Annex 1, Code of Construction Practice, to present the results of noise and vibration monitoring carried out within the London Borough of Camden (LBC) during the month of May 2020.

A number of worksites were active during the reporting month in the LBC area. Noise monitoring was undertaken adjacent to the following worksites.

Works at on-network worksite C included vegetation removal to enable structural assessment of the Park Village East parapet wall, general surveying, installation trackside hoarding and ground investigation works.

Works at on-network worksites D, E and F included installation of site temporary services, installation of working platforms, installation of scaffolding, site setup, construction of drilling fluid slabs and test piling.

Works at on-network worksites G and H included cutline installation, demolition works, cable management system installation, high level cabling installation and lighting installation.

Materials processing and ancillary activities were undertaken at the DB Cargo and former Addison Lee worksite (ref. S001-WS01).

Materials storage and laydown were underway at the 132 and 140 Hampstead road and Petrol Station worksite (ref. S001-WS02).

Demolition and groundworks were undertaken at the Regent's Park Estate worksite (ref. S001-WS07).

At Wolfson House, Walkden House, 67-75 & 77-79 Euston Rd, worksite (ref. S003-WS03) work activities involved demolition and propping.

Processing of arisings was underway at the Ibis Hotel, 3 Cardington Street worksite (ref. S003-WS05).

Deliveries were made to the Former National Temperance Hospital, 110 Hampstead Road worksite (ref. S003-WS06).

Groundworks were underway at the 93-103 Drummond Street, 11-15 Melton Street, 54-64 Euston Street and 69 Cobourg Street worksite (ref. S003-WS07).

At the One Euston Square, 40 Melton Street, Grant Thornton House, 22 Melton Street worksite (ref. S003-WS09) demolition and scaffolding were undertaken.

Euston utilities diversions were underway on Stephenson Way, Gower Street, North Gower Street and Euston Street. Additional activities were undertaken within proximity to Euston Station which included signalling & telecoms maintenance, track maintenance, overhead line inspections, grinding, arc welding, points motor replacement, fixing and containment, tanking points, drilling of sleepers, crossing replacements and installation of demarcation posts.

Vibration monitoring was undertaken in the vicinity of Regent's Park Estate (worksite ref. S001–WS07), the Walkden House, 67-75 & 77-79 Euston Road worksite (ref. S003-WS03), the Ibis Hotel, 3 Cardington Street & 1-3 Cobourg Street worksite (ref. S003-WS05), the Ibis Hotel, Euston Square Gardens (west) worksite (ref. S003-WS08) and Cubitt Court on Park Village East (V043) (worksite ref. S001–WS07).

Further works were also undertaken as part of the Granby Terrace Bridge utilities diversion on Stanhope Street. Works involved excavations, works to grout the water main involving breaking out tarmac, excavating and cutting into main and filling with foamed concrete. Works at Cumberland Market involved temporary tarmac removal. Removal and replacement of faulty waterworks infrastructure covers were undertaken at Albany Street.

Guideline criteria for significant adverse effects were exceeded on two occasions due to HS2 works in the LBC area during May 2020. Six complaints were received during the monitoring period. Description of complaints, results of investigations and any actions taken are detailed in Table 8 of this report.

Ambient sound	A description of the all-encompassing sound at a given location and time which will include sound from many sources near and far. Ambient sound can be quantified in terms of the equivalent continuous sound pressure level, $L_{pAeq,T}$
Decibel(s), or dB	Between the quietest audible sound and the loudest tolerable sound there is a million to one ratio in sound pressure (measured in Pascal (Pa)). Because of this wide range, a level scale called the decibel (dB) scale, based on a logarithmic ratio, is used in sound measurement. Audibility of sound covers a range of approximately 0-140dB.
Decibel(s) A- weighted, or dB(A)	The human ear system does not respond uniformly to sound across the detectable frequency range and consequently instrumentation used to measure sound is weighted to represent the performance of the ear. This is known as the 'A weighting' and is written as 'dB(A)'.
Equivalent continuous sound pressure level, or L _{Aeq,T}	An index used internationally for the assessment of environmental sound impacts. It is defined as the notional unchanging level that would, over a given period of time (T), deliver the same sound energy as the actual time-varying sound over the same period. Hence fluctuating sound levels can be described in terms of an equivalent single figure value, typically expressed as a decibel level.
Exclusion of data	Measurement of noise levels can be affected by weather conditions such as prolonged periods of rain, winds speeds higher than 5m/s and snow/ice ground cover. Noise levels measured during these periods are considered not representative of normal noise conditions at the site and, for the purposes of this report, are excluded from the assessment of exceedances and calculation of typical noise levels and are also greyed out in charts. Identifiable incongruous noise and vibration events not attributable to HS2 construction noise are also excluded.
Façade	A facade noise level is the noise level 1m in front of a large reflecting surface. The effect of reflection, is to produce a slightly higher (typically +2.5 to +3 dB) sound level than it would be if the reflecting surface was not there.
Free-field	A free-field noise level is the noise level measured at a location where no reflective surfaces, other than the ground, lies within 3.5 metres of the microphone position.
Peak particle velocity, or PPV	Instantaneous maximum velocity reached by a vibrating element as it oscillates about its rest position. The PPV is a simple indicator of perceptibility and risk of damage to structures due to vibration. It is usually measured in mm/s.
Sound pressure level	The parameter by which sound levels are measured in air. It is measured in decibels. The threshold of hearing has been set at 0dB, while the threshold of pain is approximately 120dB. Normal speech is approximately 60dB at a distance of 1 metre and a change of 3dB in a time varying sound signal is commonly regarded as being just detectable. A change of 10dB is subjectively twice, or half, as loud.
Vibration dose value, or VDV	An index used to evaluate human exposure to vibration in buildings. While the PPV provides information regarding the magnitude of single vibration events, the VDV provides a measure of the total vibration experienced over a specified period of time (typically 16h daytime and 8h night-time). It takes into account the magnitude, the number and the duration of vibration events and can be used to quantify exposure to continuous, impulsive, occasional and intermittent vibration. The vibration dose value is measured in m/s ^{1.75} .

1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 The nominated undertaker is required to undertake noise (and vibration) monitoring as necessary to comply with the requirements of the High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Environmental Minimum Requirements, including specifically Annex 1: Code of Construction Practice, in addition to any monitoring requirements arising from conditions imposed through consents under section 61 of the Control of Pollution Act, 1974 or through Undertakings & Assurances given to third parties. Such monitoring may be undertaken for the following purposes:
 - monitoring the impact of construction works;
 - to investigate complaints, incidents and exceedance of trigger levels; or
 - monitoring the effectiveness of noise and vibration control measures.

Monitoring data and interpretive reports are to be provided to each relevant local authority on a monthly basis and shall include a summary of the construction activities occurring, the data recorded over the monitoring period, any complaints received, any periods in exceedance of agreed trigger levels, the results of any investigations and any actions taken or mitigation measures implemented. This report provides noise data, and interpretation thereof, for monitoring carried out by HS2 within the London Borough of Camden (LBC) for the period 1st to 31st May 2020.

- 1.1.2 Active construction sites in the local authority area during this period include:
 - On-network HS2 preparatory works: worksite ref. C (see plan 2 in Appendix A)
 - Works included vegetation removal to enable structural assessment of the Park Village East parapet wall, general surveying, installation trackside hoarding and ground investigation works.
 - On-network HS2 preparatory works: worksites ref. D, E and F (see plans 2 and 3 in Appendix A)
 - Works included installation of site temporary services, installation of working platforms, installation of scaffolding, site clearance including vegetation clearance and scrub, installation and adaptation of hoarding, construction of drilling fluid slabs and test piling.
 - On-network HS2 preparatory works: worksites ref. G and H (see plan 3 in Appendix A)
 - Works included cutline installation, demolition works, cable management system installation, high level cabling installation and lighting installation.
 - DB Cargo shed and adjacent land on Granby Terrace, worksite ref. S001-WS01 (see plan 2 in Appendix A)
 - Works included materials processing and ancillary activities.

- 132 and 140 Hampstead Road and Petrol Station, worksite ref. S001-WS02 (see plan 2 in Appendix A)
 - Works included material storage and laydown.
- Regent's Park Estate, worksite ref. S001–WS07 (see plan 2 and 3 in Appendix A)
 - Works activities included demolition and groundworks.
- Wolfson House, Walkden House, 67-75 & 77-79 Euston Rd, worksite ref. S003-WS03 (see plan 3 in Appendix A)
 - Works activities included demolition and propping.
- Ibis Hotel, 3 Cardington Street, worksite ref. S003-WS05 (see plan 3 in Appendix A)
 - Work activities included processing of arisings.
- Former National Temperance Hospital, 110 Hampstead Road, worksite ref. S003-WS06 (see plan 3 in Appendix A)
 - Site activities included deliveries.
- 93-103 Drummond Street, 11-15 Melton Street, 54-64 Euston Street, 69 Cobourg Street, worksite ref. S003-WS07 (see plan 3 in Appendix A)
 - Works activities included groundworks.
- One Euston Square, 40 Melton Street, Grant Thornton House, 22 Melton Street, worksite ref. S003-WS09 (see plan 3 in Appendix A)
 - Works activities included scaffolding and demolition.
- Vehicle Holding Area, worksite ref. VLH (see plan 1 in Appendix A)
 - Works activities included surveying, site clearance and installation of hoarding were undertaken.

Works to divert utilities were also undertaken at the London on Stanhope Street as part of the Granby Terrace Bridge utilities diversion (GTB Utilities). Utility works involved excavations, works to grout the water main, involving breaking out of tarmac, excavating and cutting into main and filling with foamed concrete. Works at Cumberland Market involved temporary tarmac removal. Faulty hydroguard covers were removed and replaced at Albany Street. Water mains and sewers diversion works were undertaken in Park Village East, Delancey Street, Stanhope Street, Mornington Terrace and Augustus Street.

2 Summary of results

2.1 Exceedances of SOAEL

- 2.1.1 The significant observed adverse effect levels (SOAEL) is defined in the Planning Practice Guidance Noise as the level above which "noise causes a material change in behaviour and/or attitude, e.g. avoiding certain activities during periods of intrusion; where there is no alternative ventilation, having to keep windows closed most of the time because of the noise. Potential for sleep disturbance resulting in difficulty in getting to sleep, premature awakening and difficulty in getting back to sleep. Quality of life diminished due to change in acoustic character of the area."
- 2.1.2 Where construction noise levels exceed the SOAEL, relevant periods will be identified and summary statistics provided in order to evaluate ongoing qualification for noise insulation and temporary rehousing.
- 2.1.3 Table 3 presents a summary of recorded exceedances of the SOAEL due to HS2 related construction noise at each measurement location over the reporting period, including the number of exceedances during each time period.

- 2.1.4 Noise levels above the SOAEL during periods of works were measured at monitoring locations JC, N002 and N011. High noise levels measured at JC were found to be due to Network Rail maintenance works, and at N002 were found to be caused by roadworks; in both cases the works were not related to HS2 and are not considered further in this report. SOAEL exceedances at N011 were caused by utility diversion works and are attributable to HS2 construction noise, however works were in-line with best practicable means and relevant section 61 consents
- 2.1.5 For the purpose of assessing eligibility for noise insulation or temporary rehousing, multiple exceedances of the SOAEL in a 24-hour period would be counted as a single exceedance during that day. Over the reporting period, the overall number of SOAEL exceedances at each measurement location is shown in Table 4 and may be lower than the total sum of individual exceedances reported in Table 3 for each location.

2.1.6 Monitoring of vibration peak particle velocity (PPV) was undertaken with the purpose of ensuring that construction generated vibration are not of such a magnitude to damage adjacent buildings, in accordance with Annex 1: Code of Construction Practice of the High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Environmental Minimum Requirements. No exceedances of the Code of Construction Practice criteria due to vibration caused by HS2 vibration were measured. There are no LOAEL and SOAEL criteria based on PPV applicable to HS2 construction vibration.

2.2 Summary of measured noise and vibration levels

- 2.2.1 Table 5 presents a summary of the measured noise levels at each monitoring location over the reporting period. The $L_{Aeq,T}$ is presented for each of the relevant time periods averaged over the calendar month, along with the highest single period $L_{Aeq,T}$ that was found to occur within the month.
- 2.2.2 Noise monitoring in the vicinity of worksites G, H, S001-WS01, S001-WS07, S003-WS03 and S003-WS09 is considered representative of HS2 works in LBC during periods of construction works. Other worksites were not considered to be giving rise to substantial levels of HS2 related construction noise, with the measured noise levels largely dominated by the underlying ambient noise, acknowledging that intermittent HS2 works may on occasion be taking place within the area.

2.2.3 Table 6 presents a summary of the measured vibration levels at monitoring locations over the reporting period. During the monitoring high values of PPV were measured at V043 and V002 which were due to local disturbance of the vibration monitors and are not representative of HS2 construction works. These have been greyed out in the charts alongside other periods of local disturbance of the monitor as shown in Appendix B, and have been excluded to calculate values in Table 6. The highest PPV measured during the monitoring along any axis is presented in the table.

- 2.2.4 Construction vibration during the month was mainly due to demolition activities and may on occasion be perceptible at receptors nearby but was below levels that may cause structural damage to surrounding buildings.
- 2.2.5 Appendix C presents graphs of noise and vibration monitoring data over the month for each of the measurement locations. Noise data presented consists of the hourly L_{Aeq} values and, where relevant, the L_{Aeq,T} values (where the time period T has been taken to be the averaging period as specified in Table 1 of HS2 Information Paper E23). Vibration data presented consist of hourly PPV values.
