JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim (or the part struck out) has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

- 1 The claim was presented in March 2013. The respondent went into liquidation and a liquidator was appointed. The claimant has not responded to correspondence asking how she intends to proceed with the claim sent by the Employment Tribunal over a considerable period.
- 2 On 21 May 2019 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim or part of the claim should not be struck out.

3 The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
