A5036 Port of Liverpool access scheme – response to request for information under Environmental Information Regulations 2004 – visits by Highways England staff to Peel Ports – EIR 100680

I refer to your request under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 for information about visits by Highways England staff to Peel Ports in the two years to the date your request was received on 30 December 2019.

I am writing to advise you that we do not hold any further information concerning such visits beyond that provided in our response to EIR 100135 on 10 September 2019. No further meetings with Peel Ports have taken place in the intervening period, nor presentations, exhibitions or tours of the facility.

This being the case, the further information you have asked for falls under Regulation 12(4)(a) in that we do not hold the information requested. I refer you, therefore, back to our earlier response.
