## JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

The judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that

 The claimant's claim for unpaid accrued holiday pay in terms of the Working Time Regulations 1998 succeeds in the sum of **Two Hundred and Four**

- The claimant's claim in respect of failure to provide written statement of employment particulars succeeds, and the claimant is awarded the sum of Two Hundred and Sixty Two Pounds (£262.00); and
- 3. Both those sums are payable immediately to the claimant; and
- 4. The remainder of the claimant's claims against the respondent including the claimant's claims of unlawful deduction from wages are dismissed.
