JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

1. The claimant presented a claim on 16 September 2019, claiming non payment of wages. A hearing was fixed for 29 November 2019 at which the claimant failed to attend. No explanation for this was provided.

2. On 29 November 2019 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 13 December 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
