JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

- The Employment Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 22 January 2020 regarding the identity of his employer, requesting a response by 5 February 2020. The claimant did not respond.
- 2 On 28 February 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 13 March 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- 3 The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
