JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. The Employment Tribunal wrote to the claimant on 22 January 2020 regarding the identity of his employer, requesting a response by 5 February 2020. The claimant did not respond.
2. On 28 February 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 13 March 2020 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
