

Staying safe online

Top ten tips

- Before you post any message online, stop, think and be sure it is really what you want to say
 - Never post personal details like your address, phone number, email details or passwords
- 3 Ask yourself, do you really want to share that picture or video? Once it's out there you lose all control
 - Be careful what you download.

 If you think it might be illegal
 don't do it
 - Be aware that not everyone is who they say they are. Never arrange to meet someone you have met online



- Make your privacy settings as high as possible
- If someone is trying to bully you online, don't respond block them
 - BDon't share any messages you receive that involve bullying or abusing someone else and don't share anything which you think might be illegal
 - If anything is making you feel worried, talk to your parents or a teacher
