I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that no information in the scope of your request

is held. This is because the MOD does not hold any recorded information on the volume of post for the VAPC.

Under Section 16 (Advice and Guidance) it may be helpful to explain that the Ministry of Defence provides secretariat support for the Veterans Advisory and Pensions Committee (VAPC). The flow of post to and from the VAPC is negligible. This is because most correspondence received for the VAPC is conducted by email and therefore the VAPC receives very little in the way of postal correspondence.
