JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated **06/02/2020** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because
 - it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out, on the grounds that it has no reasonable prospect of success as the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction.
