JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated **06/02/2020** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because

- it has no reasonable prospect of success.

2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out, on the grounds that it has no reasonable prospect of success as the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction.
