JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim for accrued holiday pay on termination of employment is upheld and the respondent shall pay the claimant £278.08.
- 2. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claimant's claim for underpayment of holiday pay during his employment as it is time-barred.
- 3. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction from wages is dismissed.
- 4. The respondent shall pay the claimant £2,100 under the Employment Rights Act 1996, section 38 for failure to provide the claimant with a written statement of particulars of employment. This figure equates to four weeks' pay, capped at £525 per week.
