AMENDED JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant was unfairly and wrongfully dismissed by the Second Respondent, Silver Hopkins Hotel Management Ltd and the Second Respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the Claimant of the sum of £13867.33. The Employment Protection (Recoupment of Benefits) Regulations 1996 as amended do not apply. The reason for dismissal was that the Claimant was redundant.
- 2. The First and Second Respondents do pay to the Claimant the sum of £2,941.90 for failure to consult pursuant to the TUPE transfer duties.
