## JUDGMENT

## Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. This hearing was listed as a preliminary hearing. Pursuant to rule 48 of the 2013 Rules, it is ordered to be treated as a final hearing.

- 3. It is declared and ordered that:
  - 1. The claimant is entitled to a statutory redundancy payment of £12,267.
