Thank you for your email received by the Ministry Of Defence on 18th May 2020 requesting the following information:

"How many service personnel are currently at rank OF-7 or above?

How many of these people have their ethnicity as recorded on the JPA database as being of white background?

What is the highest rank of a BAME officer and how many of them are there at that level in each of the services?"

We are treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

We have now completed a search for the information you requested, and I can confirm that all information in scope of your request is held.

As to part 1 of your request; as at 1 April 2020 there are 140 Regular personnel at a rank of OF-7 and above.

As to part 2 of your request; as at 1 April 2020 of the 140 Regular personnel at a rank of OF-7 and above; all 140 have an ethnicity declared as white.

As to part 3 of your request the highest rank of a Regular BAME officer is OF-6 and there are less than 5 personnel at this rank, who are split between the Royal Navy/Royal Marines, the Army, and the RAF.
