For each branch/trade of the RAF can I have;

- 1. The trained regular strength broken down by rank;
- 2. The average total length of service on promotion;
- 3. The average age on promotion
- 4. A demographic breakdown by rank and age
- 5. A demographic breakdown by rank and length of service

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).
