Re: S31 Grant Determination Letter for the Bercow: 10 Years On grant 2018-19 ([DfE Ref GR1000702; MHCLG 31/3537)

This Determination is made between:

- (1) The Secretary of State for Education and
- (2) The local authorities listed at Annex A.

I am pleased to confirm the details of the Government's offer to the Council following agreement that the grant above should be devolved.

We are devolving this Grant under a Section 31 non-ring fenced transfer (Local Government Finance Act 2003). Our expectation is that the Council will use the funds to support the aims of the Opportunity Areas programme, and in particular the speech, language and communication skills of young people in the area.

The Senior Responsible Owner for this Grant, Hannah Streatfeild, will require your responsible officer to confirm at the end of each financial year that the funding has been properly expended.

This is a one-off grant, over and above the main Opportunity Area funding.

Purpose of the Grant

The Council can spend this grant to promote activity in the Opportunity Area that will improve the social mobility outcomes of children and young people. But, whilst you may choose how to spend the money in order to best meet local need, we expect these funds to be used to promote better speech, language and communication skills among young people in the areas. Detailed proposals have been proposed by each area for this, and we look forward to seeing them taken forward.

New Burdens

The main OA grant referred to above is already being used by the local authorities concerned to pay the salary of the local project manager, who is helping to deliver the OA programme. It can also be used to fund any additional new burdens associated with this new, related grant.

Arrangements for keeping in touch with the Department for Education and the Head of Delivery

Formal reporting to the Department for Education on progress is not a condition of this grant. The Department for Education will, however, ask the Council to provide a voluntary end of year return and report confirming activity that has taken place or been funded.

The Department for Education would also be happy to receive any information about effective practice and activity that substantively addresses social mobility across all life stages of children and young people.

This letter has been copied to the Directors of Children's Services in all participating local authorities, Opportunity Area Heads of Delivery, Her Majesty's Treasury and the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government.

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as the Bercow: 10 Years On Grant Determination (2018-19) [31/3537].
