The **start date** for the above Order is 21 July 2020.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the public footpath running from a point A (OS Map Ref 398966 406404) on the detached footway at the junction of Woods Lane and Delph New Road, Dobcross in a northerly direction for a distance of 53 metres to point B (OS Map Ref 398940 406452) adjacent to the turning head adjacent to 3 Treetops Close, Dobcross and create an alternative footpath instead on a line running from a point B (OS Map Ref 398940 406452) adjacent to the turning head adjacent to 3 Treetops Close, Dobcross in a south westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres to point C (OS Map Ref 398933 406431) on the footpath to Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School, Dobcross, having a minimum width of 2 metres, as shown on the order map.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 27 October 2020]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (PART OF FOOTPATH 119 SADDLEWORTH) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

This order is made by Oldham Borough Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that —

(a) an application for planning permission has been made under Part 3 of that Act, namely the change of use of land adjacent to 1, 2 and 3 Treetops Close, Dobcross to garden use associated with the dwellings (PA/340311/17), and

(b) if the application were granted it would be necessary to authorise the diversion of the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable the development to be carried out.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted and the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map and statement shall be modified as described below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Oldham Borough Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Oldham Borough Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with and upon the occurrence of that diversion the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it the path or way referred to in paragraph 1 of this order and the

path or way referred to in paragraph 2 of this order shall be added to it, and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule.

4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.


