Most students will receive results this summer so that they can progress to further study or employment as expected. We have put in place special arrangements so that results can be awarded despite exam cancellations.

Where appropriate, adapted assessments mean these qualifications continue to signal students' occupational competence. Results achieved this year will have the same value as previous and future years. We've set out [full details about this year's arrangements](#) on our website.

All GCSEs, AS and A levels

Students' grades have been determined by calculating results, combining evidence from their schools and colleges and [a statistical standardisation process](#).

Outcomes at national level will be broadly stable when compared to previous years.

Functional skills, some vocational, technical and other general qualifications

Most students will receive calculated results, using evidence from results already achieved and grades from their teachers and tutors who have considered their performance across the course, awarding organisations' quality assurance and checks on overall qualification outcomes.

Other vocational and technical qualifications (where a calculated result isn't appropriate, because practical skills need to be tested or there's insufficient evidence available)

Students took adapted assessments, where possible, such as online assessment instead of face-to-face, or a practical simulation instead of a workplace observation.

Adaptations were agreed by awarding organisations and supported by industry-relevant professional bodies.

In some cases, an adapted assessment wasn't possible and the assessment was delayed.

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
