JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By email dated **17 June 2020** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to write by 4pm on 25 June 2020 to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out because
 - the claimant had not complied with case management orders 2 and 3 issued following the hearing dated **26 May 2020.** (Such orders having been sent to the Claimant by the judge immediately after the hearing, and then sent again by tribunal staff.)
 - the claim has not been actively pursued. (The Claimant did not attend the hearing on 26 May 2020 and did not answer his phone when called by the judge that day, who left a voicemail. He has not written to the tribunal or to the respondent since then to explain his absence or to comply with directions or at all.)
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, as to why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out.
- 3. The hearing fixed for 8 July 2020 will not take place.
