JUDGMENT ON A PRELIMINARY HEARING

Upon hearing from the claimant and from Counsel for the respondent, the judgment of the Tribunal is that: -

- the claimant's complaint of harassment is struck out because it was presented out of time, in circumstances whereby it would not be just and equitable to extend time;
- 2. the claimant's complaints of unauthorised deductions from wages in respect of holiday pay, company shares and an alleged failure to pay Income Benefit Protection are struck out;
- 3. the claimant's remaining complaint of a failure to make reasonable adjustments shall proceed to a hearing, the date(s) of which shall be notified in due course.
