- 1. The claimant's complaint that the respondent failed to pay him accrued holiday pay is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £1,728.00 in respect of accrued holiday pay. That is a gross amount and the claimant shall be responsible for the payment of any income tax and national insurance contributions thereon.
- 2. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £540.00 by way of compensation for breach of contract (failure to pay notice pay).
