JUDGMENT

The claimant's application dated 30 April 2020 for reconsideration of the judgment sent to the parties on 17 April 2020 is refused.

REASONS

There is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked, because:

The claimant has gone through the tribunal's judgment and produces 14 pages of comments. The comments largely amount to evidence and or submissions which should have been presented by the claimant at the hearing. However, having consiered the claimant's submissions, the claimant's document has not satisfied me that a reconsideration is in the interests of justice. The claimant has pointed to parts of the Tribunal's decision which she states include wrong conclusions on the evidence, however I am not persuaded that at a reconsideration that Tribunal's decision can be shown to be wrong or that it is likely that the decision will be changed. The claimant's application for reconsideration is really an appeal against the decision of the Tribunal that is not the purpose of the reconsideration provisions in the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure
