Notes/Caveats:

- 1. Table 5 For example, personnel serve on average 14 years prior to leaving.
- Figures are for Regular Army only and therefore exclude FTRS and Gurkhas but include those individuals who have transferred from GURTAM to UKTAP.
- 3. Basic Training includes all new-entry training to provide basic military skills.
- 4. Initial Trade Training includes initial individual specialisation, sub-specialisation and technical training following Phase 1 training prior to joining the Trade Trained Strength.
- 5. Figures have been rounded to 10 for presentational purposes; numbers ending in "5" have been rounded to the nearest multiple of 20 to prevent systematic
- 6. Totals and sub-totals have been rounded separately and so may not appear to be the sum of their parts.
- 7. Table 2 is mutually exclusive from Table 1.
- 8. Table 3 is mutually exclusive from Table 1.
- 9. Prior to 2016 Basic Training and Initial Trade Training were combined and therefore cannot be broken-down.
- 10. AGC Unspecified are unknown at the point of the data being taken. However the majority, but not all will become AGC (SPS) personnel.
- 11. Length of Service (Years) is calculated as full years of service completed on Outflow.
- 12. Length of service has been calculated using entry date. There are known problems with the entry date information extracted from Joint Personnel Administration System (JPA) which is supposed to reflect their 'current entry date' but if personnel have transferred to the Army from another Service, served under an alternative assignment type (e.g. reserve forces), are re-entrants or have transferred from Other Ranks to Officers, their entry date may correspond to any of these events. The resulting LoS may reflect their current period of service, include previous service, or it may be the time that has elapsed since they first joined the Armed Forces, irrespective of any break in service.
- 13. Unrounded figures are used in the calculation of percentages.
- 14. "~" denotes fewer than 5.
