I'm writing to let you know that we consider your application to be of high public interest.

We consider your application to be of high public interest because:

There have been historic issues with the Bankwood Lane Waste Treatment and Processing Centre, with a high level of complaints from a significant number of people over the previous 12-18 months. There has also been media interest in the past and MP and Councillor involvement. As the site is proposing to significantly expand its operations, there is likely to be increased community and media interest in the site.

If you do not consider your application to be of high public interest, you should discuss this with us at the earliest opportunity.

This will involve additional work including extra consultation with the public on your application. We will need to charge for costs we incur that are not covered by the application charge on a time and materials basis. We will charge £100 an hour.
