Welfare of Animals at the Time of Killing (Wales) Regulations 2014	For appeals see regulation 22	The Tribunal may suspend the effect of the regulator's decision. The appellant must make an application to the Tribunal.
Equine Identification (Wales) Regulations 2019	For appeals against a compliance notice see regulation 37 For appeals against a non-compliance penalty see regulation 38 For appeals against a fixed monetary penalty see regulation 39 For appeals against enforcement costs see regulation 40	An appeal under this regulation suspends the effect of the notice appealed against until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
Equine Identification (England) Regulations 2018	For appeals against a compliance notice see regulation 39 For appeals against a non-compliance penalty see regulation 40 For appeals against a fixed monetary penalty see regulation 41 For appeals against enforcement costs see regulation 42	An appeal under this regulation suspends the effect of the notice appealed against until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
Mandatory Use of Closed Circuit Television [CCTV] in Slaughterhouses (England) Regulations 2018	For appeals see regulation 7	The Tribunal may suspend the effect of the regulator's decision. The appellant must make an application to the Tribunal.
Welfare of Animals at the Time of Killing (England) Regulations 2015	For appeals see regulation 22	The Tribunal may suspend the effect of the regulator's decision. The appellant must make an application to the Tribunal.
The Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) (England) Regulations 2018	For appeal see regulation 24. Please see Schedule 1 for Licensable activities	The Tribunal may suspend the effect of the regulator's decision. The appellant must make an application to the Tribunal.
