Your request for information to the Office of Manpower Economics (OME) dated 28 February, 2020- Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your email of 28 February 2020 requesting the following information from the NHS Pay Review Body.

- The names of any planned/upcoming HR change and transformation projects/programmes? Who will these affect?
- Which new HR systems are being implemented in the organisation, if any?
- Is there is any planned organisational restructure, which departments will be affected?
- Is the organisation is going through any major acquisitions/mergers?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require;
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

The Office of Manpower Economics (OME) provides an independent secretariat to eight Pay Review Bodies. They are **NHS Pay Review Body (NHSPRB)**, Doctors' & Dentists' Remuneration Body (DDRB), Senior Salaries Review Body (SSRB), School Teachers Review Body (STRB), Police Remuneration Review Body (PRRB), National Crime Agency Remuneration Review Body (NCAPRB) and the Armed Forces Pay Review Body (AFPRB) and as such we are responsible for any administrative queries for all the secretariats mentioned above.

The OME does not hold the information you have requested.

The OME is funded by the <u>Department for Business</u>, <u>Energy and Industrial Strategy</u> (BEIS). BEIS is responsible for all HR matters and change & transformation programmes.

Due to the nature of the information that you are seeking, your request may be more appropriately addressed to the <u>Department of Business</u>, <u>Energy and Industrial</u> <u>Strategy</u>, who may be able to assist you with your request.
