# <u>Services provided by the British Consulate General's consular section:</u>

## Assistance if you are:

Hospitalised, a victim of crime, arrested/detained, destitute, otherwise distressed.

## **Emergency Travel Documents (ETD)**

If your passport is lost, stolen, damaged, full, expired, or has fewer than 6 months' validity.

# **Notarial services**

Certified true copies, letters for Certificate of No Criminal Conviction from Hong Kong Police, oaths, declarations and affidavits, witness signatures (**NB** – we cannot issue notarial acts in certain cases, e.g. if for use in Hong Kong. If in doubt, please call or email us for advice.)

# Note that you must make an appointment to obtain an ETD or notarial service.
