JUDGMENT

1. The response is struck out.

2. The claims of unauthorised deductions from wages and breach of contract succeed, remedy will be determined at the listed hearing.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated **31/07/2020** the Tribunal gave the respondent an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the response should not be struck out because
 - it is not being actively pursued.
 - The respondent is in breach of the Tribunal's Order.

In Particular:

- The respondent has failed to comply with the Tribunal's Order of 15 May 2020 as particularised in the claimant's email of 29 June 2020.
- The respondent has failed to reply to the Tribunal's letter of 7 July 2020.
- 2. The respondent has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The response is therefore struck out.
- 3. The respondent will be only be entitled to participate in any hearing in respect of Miss Haze's claim to the extent permitted by the Employment Judge.
