**Llanbrynmair Onshore Wind Farm Redetermination – Request for Further Information following the Withdrawal of the Carnedd Wen Onshore Wind Farm application**

Following the withdrawal of the Carnedd Wen onshore wind farm application by the developer in February 2020, the Secretary of State is seeking information as to whether this has resulted in any changes to the project as previously applied for, such as the proposal to share an Abnormal Indivisible Load route with Carnedd Wen.

Your response to the Secretary of State is requested by 8 September 2020. This request is made without prejudice to the Secretary of State's decision whether or not to grant consent for the Llanbrynmair onshore wind farm, and nothing in this letter is to be taken to imply what that decision might be or what final conclusions the Secretary of State may reach and by when.
