

The Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 introduced a marine planning system for the UK. Development and application of marine plans will lead to more strategic and efficient management of our marine resources. The Secretary of State has delegated the production of marine plans to the Marine Management Organisation (MMO).

The MMO has commissioned a project called 'External Decision Making and Implementation Mapping of Marine Plans' that is being conducted on behalf of the MMO by MarineSpace Ltd and Howell Marine Consulting.
