INTRODUCTION

The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care has announced a scheme of payments for people on low incomes in areas with a high incidence of Coronavirus, who need to self-isolate and are unable to work from home. Applications, payments and disputes are the responsibility of Local Authorities. The scheme started on 1.9.20.

ELIGIBILITY

- 2 Eligibility is restricted to people who are resident in Blackburn with Darwen, Oldham or Pendle and who meet the following criteria:
 - 1. They have received notification from NHS Test and Trace;
 - 2. They have agreed to comply with the notification from NHS Test and Trace and provided contact details to their LA;
 - 3. They are employed or self-employed;
 - **4.** They are unable to work from home and will lose income as a result.
 - **5.** They are currently receiving UC, WTC, ESA(IR), JSA(IB), IS or SPC or HB.

Virus infection rates are monitored and the scope of the scheme may be subject to change in the future.



THE TREATMENT OF PAYMENTS FOR ESA(IR), JSA(IB) and IS PURPOSES

Payments under this scheme are treated as Local Welfare Provision and disregarded for purposes of ESA(IR)¹, JSA(IB)² and IS³.

THE TREATMENT OF PAYMENTS FOR SPC PURPOSES
