## THE HORNSEA ONE OFFSHORE WIND FARM ORDER 2014 (AS AMENDED) VARIATION 1 (SCHEDULES 8-10) AND VARIATION 2 (SCHEDULE 11)

On 20 July 2016 the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) received a request from DONG Energy on behalf of the Project One Companies (Heron Wind Ltd, Njord Ltd and Vi-Aura Ltd) to vary the Deemed Marine Licences (dMLs) contained within Schedules 8-11 of The Hornsea One Offshore Wind Farm Order 2014 (as amended). An update to this request was received on 17 August 2016.

In determining the request to vary the dMLs, the MMO has carefully considered the supporting information provided by DONG Energy. The MMO has now completed its consideration of the variation request.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(3)(d) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, the MMO has made the amendments to the dMLs set out in the attached notices of variation.

Please find enclosed the notices of variation and copies of the dML as varied for ease of reference. In accordance with regulation 3 of The Marine Licensing (Notices Appeals) Regulations 2011, you may appeal the notice of variation to the First-tier Tribunal. If you wish to appeal then in accordance with Rule 22(1)(b) of the Tribunal Procedure (First-tier Tribunal) (General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009 (SI 2009/1976) you have 28 days from the date of the sending of the notice of variation to send or deliver a notice of appeal to the First-tier Tribunal.
