Application for a variation to the Able Marine Energy Park Development Consent Order 2014 (No. 2935) Deemed Marine Licence under Section 72(3)(d) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009.

I can confirm the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) received your request for a variation to the Deemed Marine Licence within Schedule 8 of the Able Marine Energy Park Development Consent Order 2014 (No. 2935) on 15 April 2020.

As the MMO is responsible for enforcing, post-consent monitoring, varying, suspending, and revoking any deemed marine licence(s) as part of the DCO, the MMO will now proceed to consider the request under section 72 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act (MCAA) 2009.
