- 1. The First Claimant's claim under case 2304199/2018 (for direct race discrimination) is not well founded and is dismissed
- 2. The First and Second Claimants claims for detriment because of race in claim number 2304309/2018 and 2300246/2019 are well founded.
- The First and Second Claimants claim for unauthorised deduction from wages in claims numbers 2304309/2018 and 2300246/2019 are not well founded.
- 4. The Tribunal declares that the Claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction from wages in claim number 2300703/2019 is well founded. - 6. The tribunal awards to the Second Claimant a sum for injury to feelings of £5,500
