## JUDGMENT ON STRIKE OUT

- 1. The whole of the claimant's claim is **struck out**.
- 2. Any hearing listed to take place is vacated and will now not take place.
- 3. The reasons for the strike out are as follows:
  - 3.1. On 26 July 2020, the Tribunal warned the claimant that it seemed she was not actively pursuing her claim and proposed to strike it out. It allowed the claimant until 3 August 2020 to make representations.
  - 3.2. The claimant made no representations.
  - 3.3. The Tribunal is therefore satisfied that the claim is not being actively pursued (Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure rule 37(1)(d));
