JUDGMENT at telephone hearing

The judgment of the tribunal, by consent, is that the claims succeed in the following respects:-

- 1 The claim for unauthorised deductions from wages is well founded and the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £2,884.60, gross.
- 2 The claim for holiday pay succeeds and the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £244.60, gross.
- 3 The contractual claim for notice succeeds and the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £2,307.68, gross.
- 4 The total of these sums is £5,436.88.

REASONS

1 This telephone hearing was convened after the video hearing failed for technological reasons and it was apparent that there was a broad measure of agreement. Two elements of the claim were agreed and the parties agreed on a figure for the third, unpaid wages. All sums are gross as, in the case of the contractual claim, I have no basis for assessing tax.
