JUDGMENT

1. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages in respect of her pay for 8 September 2019 and is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of **£61.60**
2. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages in respect of statutory sick pay for the period 19 September to 3 October 2019 and is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of **£188.50**
3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent is ordered to pay damages to the claimant in the net sum of **£260.00**.
4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's accrued holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£629.20**.
