INTRODUCTION

- 1. I am directed by the Secretary of State to draw your attention to the publication of amendments to Approved Document B (Fire Safety), volume 2: Buildings other than dwellinghouses.
- 2. The amended Approved Documents will come into force on 16 April 2019 in the circumstances set out in the formal notice of approval in Annex [A] to this Circular.
- 3. The purpose of this Circular is to:
 - draw attention to the amendments made to Approved Document B (Fire Safety), volume 2 Buildings other than dwellinghouses; and
 - announce the approval and publication of the amended Approved Documents.

APPLICATION OF THE APPROVED DOCUMENTS

4. The changes made to the Approved Documents apply only to buildings and building work in England.

TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

5. The amendments take place immediately and there is no transition arrangement.

The amendments will come into force on 16 April 2019.

- 6. Approved Document B (Fire Safety), Volume 2: Buildings other than dwellinghouses (2006 edition incorporating 2010, 2013 and November 2018 and December 2018 amendments) have been amended to correct paragraph 12.8 by replacing the text.
