



Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Request – 200803009

Thank you for your request dated 3 August in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

'I am seeking information as a representative of a victim of crime to see if a convicted murderer is being funded by the LAA in regards to an application to vary his life licence conditions after only two month of release.'

'Please can you confirm if the offender Anthony Nicolas Davison 6/7/1964 is in receipt of legal aid for the variation of exclusion zones.'

Your request has been handled under the FOIA.

The MoJ does not hold any information in the scope of your request. This is because there is no record of legal aid being paid in respect of Anthony Nicolas Davison for a variation of life licence/exclusion zones.

The FOIA does not oblige a public authority to create information to answer a request if the requested information is not held. The duty is to only provide the recorded information held.

Appeal Rights

If you are not satisfied with this response you have the right to request an internal review by responding in writing to one of the addresses below within two months of the date of this response.
