

# **NOTICE OF ORDER**

## **WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT**

### **1981 Section 53**

Derbyshire County Council  
(Footpath from the junction of Hyde Bank Road and St Georges Road to Public  
Bridleway 180 - New Mills ) Modification Order 2012

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier inquiry the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which he proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is 23 September 2020.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the County of Derbyshire for New Mills by adding to them a footpath in New Mills from Point A on the Order map (Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ('GR') SK 0020 8586) at the junction of Hyde Bank Road and St Georges Road, proceeding in a generally east, north easterly direction passing the southern boundary of Salem Cottages to Point B on the Order Map (GR SK 0030 8588). Then proceeding in a generally north easterly direction crossing land to the east of the River Sett and finally turning in a south easterly direction to junction with Bridleway No. 180 on the Sett Valley Trail at Point C on the Order Map (GR SK 0046 8601), with an overall distance of 314 metres or thereabouts and an approximate width of 2 metres.

The effect of the proposed modifications would be to:

"in the Order (but not the Order map) replace any reference to footpath with bridleway;  
in the schedule part 1 insert 'with a width of 2 metres' between 'Bridleway' and 'in'; in the schedule part 2 delete 'Approx' from 'Approx width';  
in the Order map and Order map key replace the broken black line representing a footpath with a solid line with crossbars to represent a bridleway;  
in the Order map key replace 'Footpath to be added' with 'Bridleway to be added'."

### **Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments**

#### **Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 18 November 2020]**

The Order Making Authority, the applicant and everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

#### **Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 30 December 2020]**

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

#### **In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.**

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
