Thank you for your letter of 04 March 2020 submitting the above Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The start date for the above Order is 25 September 2020.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to

#### **Creation Order**

Create a new length of Public Footpath, with a width of 1.8 metres and to be numbered ER273, commencing from a point on the unadopted highway known as Bayview Road at NGR TR 3752 4753 and running in a south-westerly direction for 170 metres to connect with the existing length of Public Footpath ER273 at NGR TR 3742 4739, as shown between the points C and A on the Order Plan.

#### **Extinguishment Order**

Extinguish the entire width of that length of Public Footpath numbered ER273 commencing from a point at its junction with the unadopted highway known as Bayview Road and running for 160 metres in a south-westerly direction, and then for a further 16 metres in a generally westerly direction, to NGR TR 3742 4739, as shown between the points B and A on the Order Plan.

All distances are approximate, all directions are general.

#### <u>Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments</u>

### Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 09 October 2020]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

## Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 20 November 2020]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation or any other person wishing to make representations in writing must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 15 weeks of the start date (<u>usually 14 but an extra week has been allocated as this falls during to the Christmas Holidays</u>) [by 08 January 2021] Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

- 2. The relevant date of this Order will be as specified in paragraph 1.
- 3. The Definitive Statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 176 [TR34NE]) shall be modified as described in part II of the schedule to the Order.


# PART II: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

The public right of way over the land situate at Ringwould with Kingsdown and shown by a bold continuous line on the attached map contained in the Order and described in Part I of the schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date the authority is satisfied that a new path, fit for public use, has been provided as replacement for the existing part of Public Footpath ER273 subject to this Order, and thereupon the Definitive Map for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 176 [TR34NW]) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. The relevant date of this Order will be as specified in paragraph 1.
- 3. The Definitive Statement for the County of Kent (Map Sheet 176 [TR34NW]) shall be modified as described in Part II of the schedule to this Order.
