Sir David Attenborough OM CH CVO CBE

Broadcaster and Natural Historian

Sir David Attenborough is recognised for his exceptional and sustained international contribution to broadcasting, natural history and the environment. Having started his career at the BBC in 1951, Sir David is best known for writing and presenting a series of landmark natural history documentaries that constitute a comprehensive survey of animal and plant life on Earth. Through his documentaries and continued support for many wildlife charities, Sir David has been one of the leading advocates for environmental issues with truly global influence.

Sir Tim Barrow KCMG LVO MBE

Political Director, Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office and UK Ambassador to the European Union

Sir Tim Barrow is recognised for his exceptional contribution to British interests overseas, over the duration of his career, including helping co-ordinate the UK's exit from the European Union. Sir Tim is one of our most experienced diplomats. He previously served as Her Majesty's Ambassador in Moscow from 2011 to 2015, and prior to that as Ambassador to Ukraine. He was appointed Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the European Union in 2017, and in 2020 became the UK's first Ambassador to the European Union, playing a crucial role in representing UK interests as a Member State and in negotiating the terms of the UK's exit. This award is a fitting recognition of his outstanding service to the UK's interests during this immensely complex and important process and over the course of his 30 year diplomatic career.

Lately European Commissioner for the Security Union

Sir Julian King is recognised for an outstanding contribution to European security. Building on a long and distinguished diplomatic career, he took on the position of EU Commissioner for Security in 2016. In this role, he made an exceptional contribution to improving security capabilities across the European continent at a time of great political change in the UK's relationship with the European Union.
