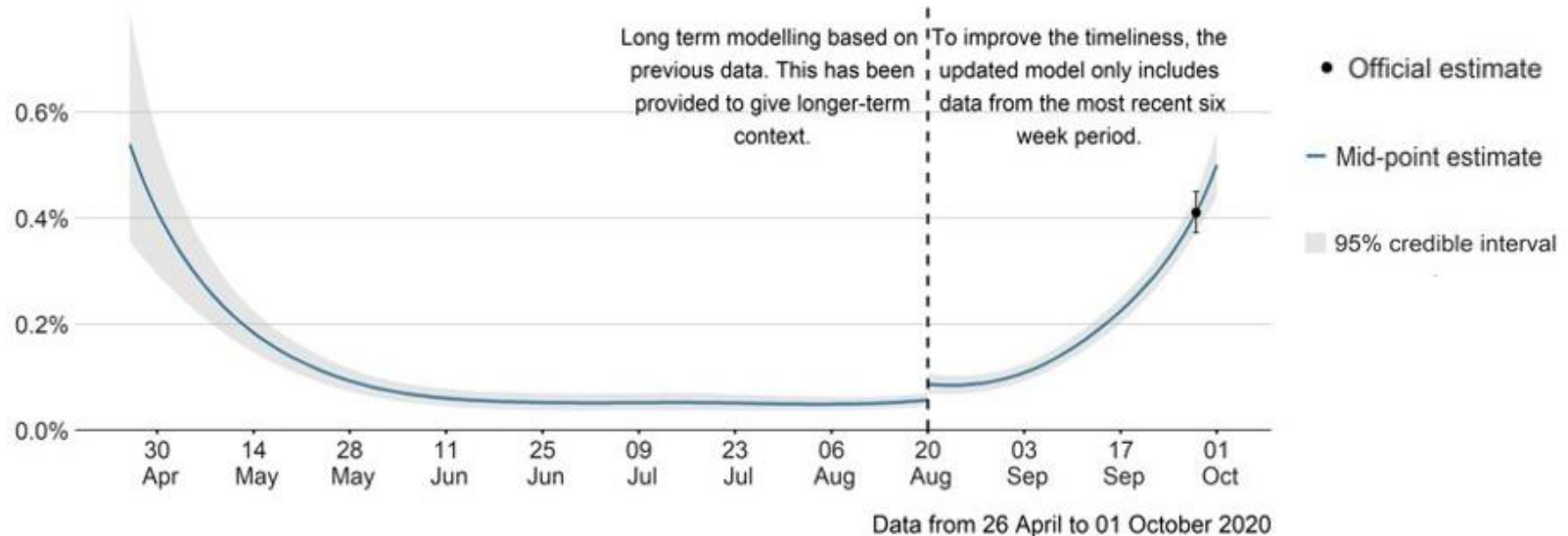


ONS COVID-19 household infection survey estimates of infection rates in England

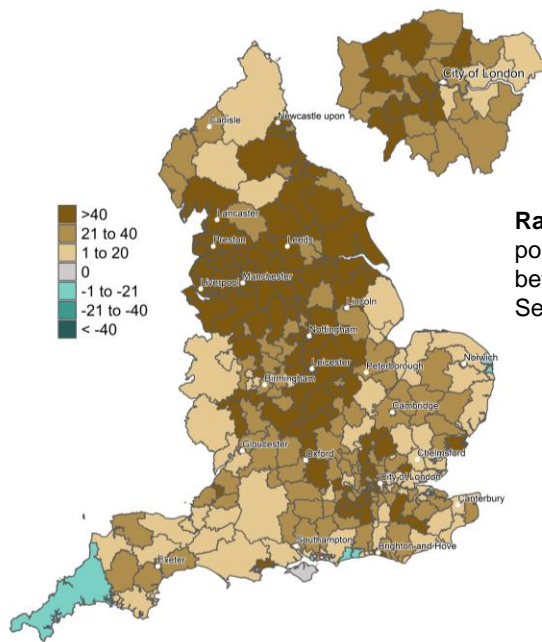
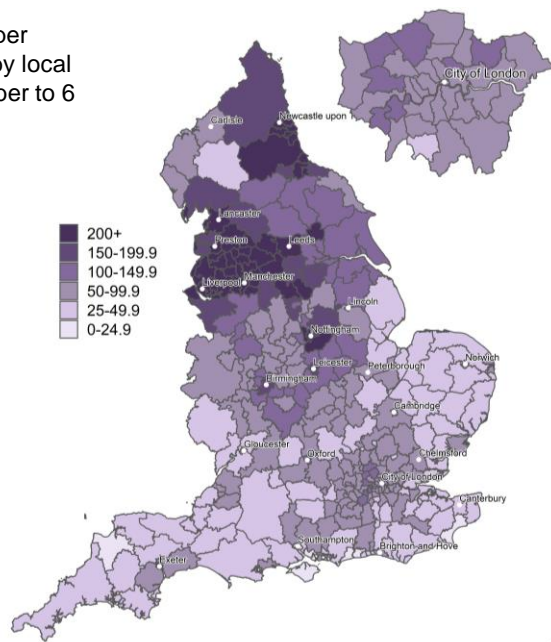
(excludes care homes, hospitals, and other institutional settings)

An estimated 224,400 people within the community population in England had COVID-19 from 25 September to 1 October. This is around 1 in 240 people.



Geographical spread of COVID-19 in England

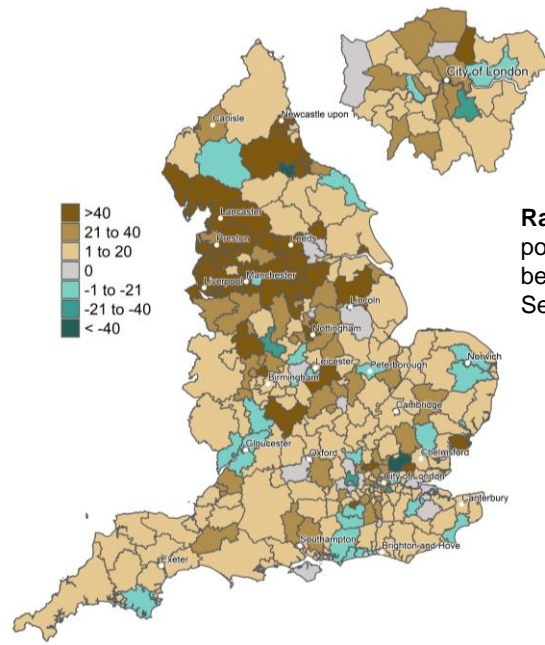
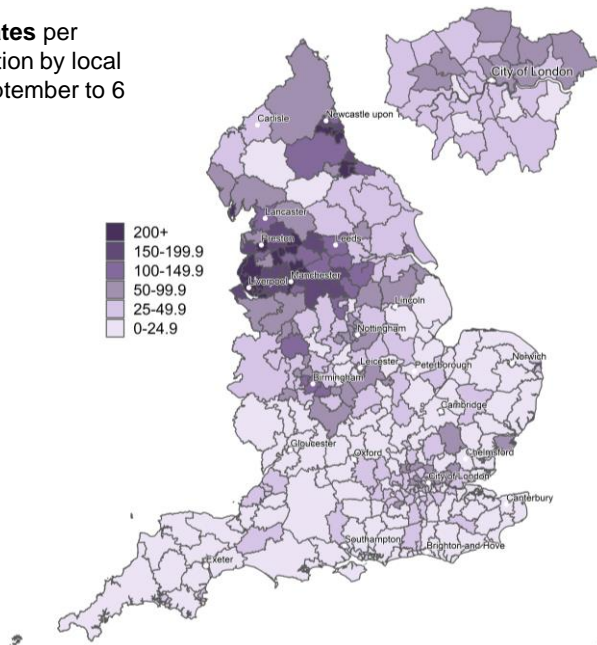
Weekly case rates per 100,000 population by local authority 30 September to 6 October



Rate change per 100,000 population by local authority between 23-29 Sept and 30 Sept to 6 Oct

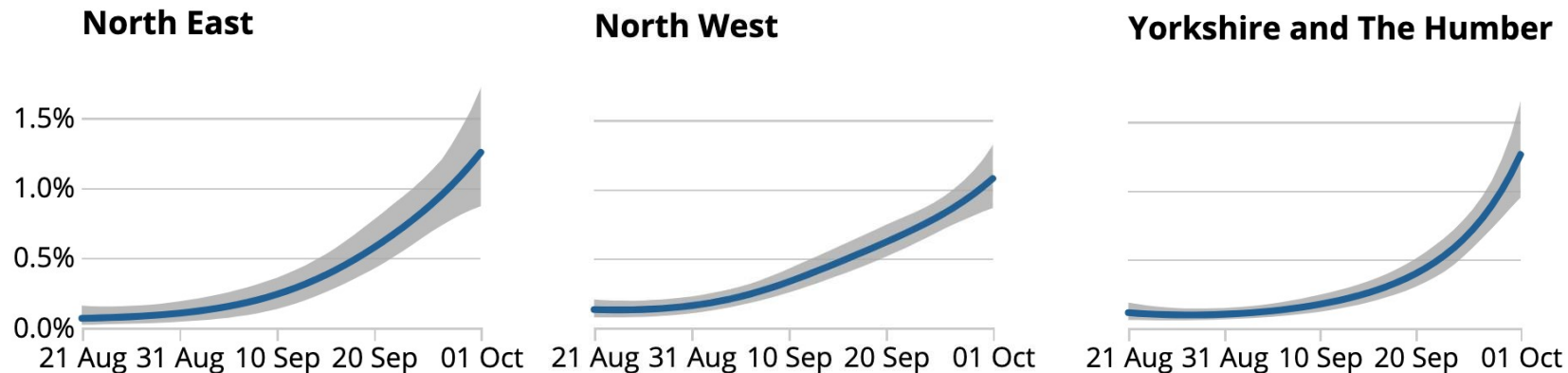
Geographical spread of COVID-19 in England (Ages 60+)

Rate change per 100,000 population by local authority between 23-29 Sept and 30 Sept to 6 Oct

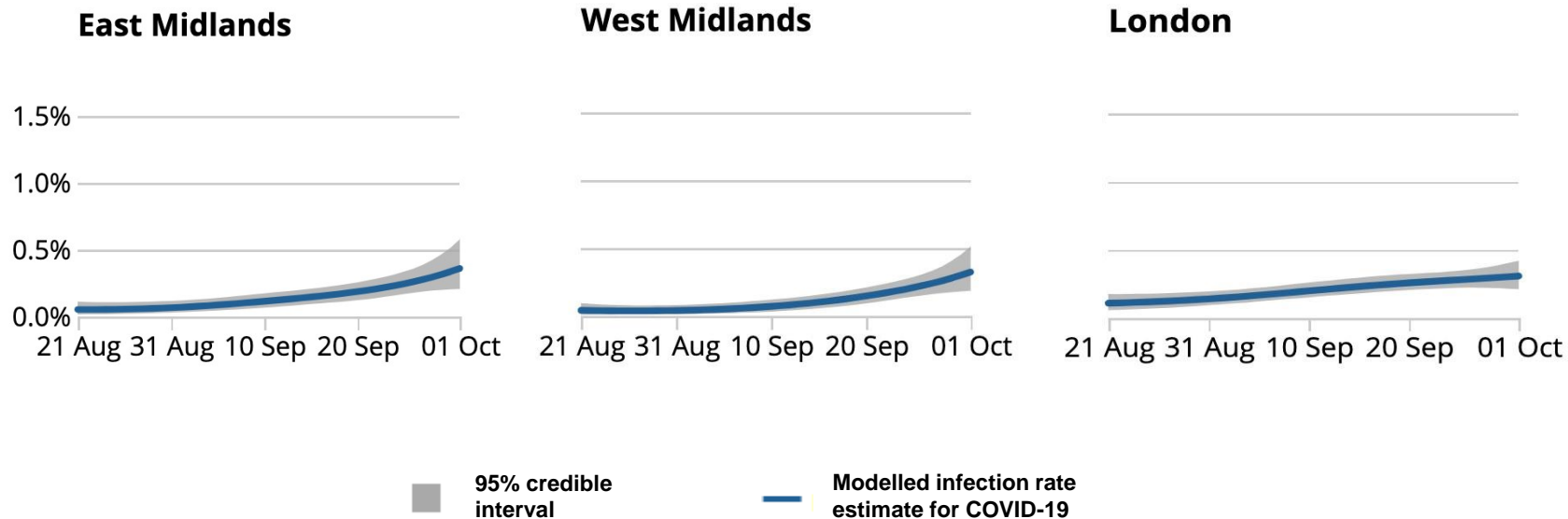

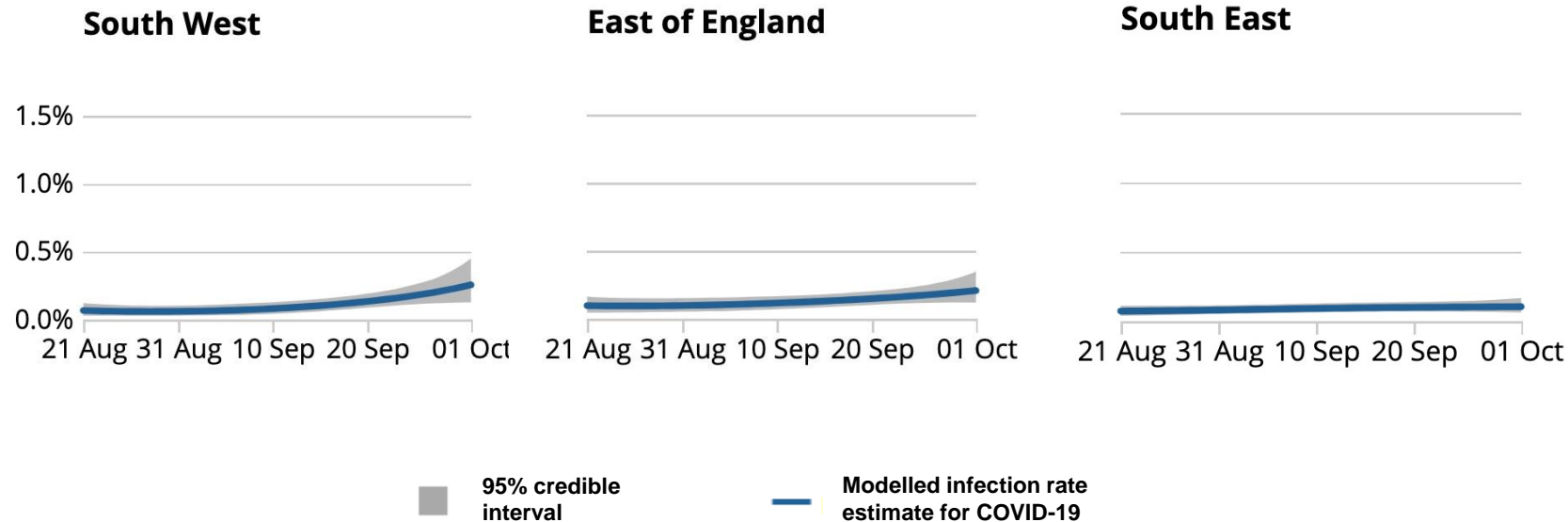

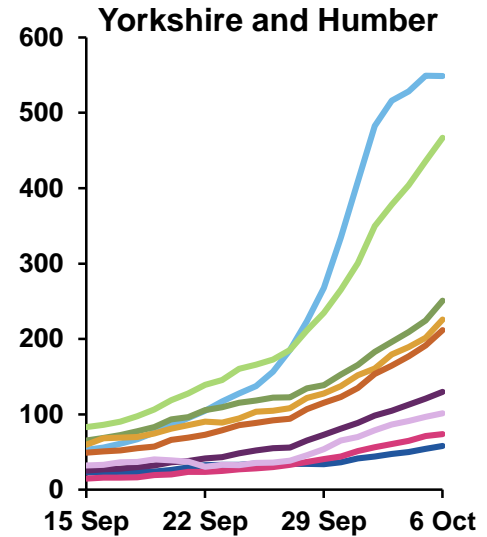
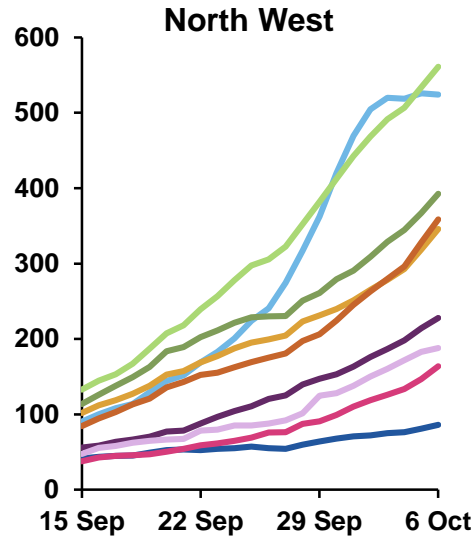
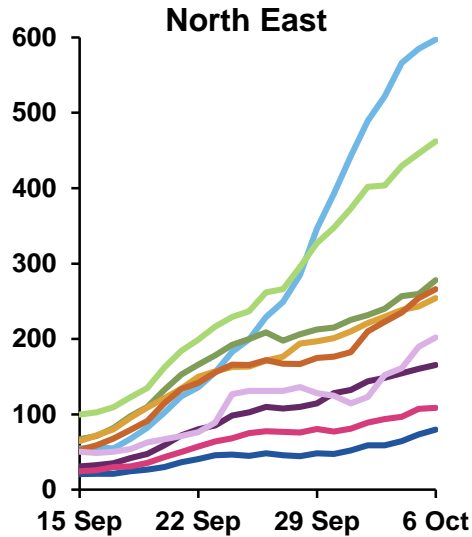

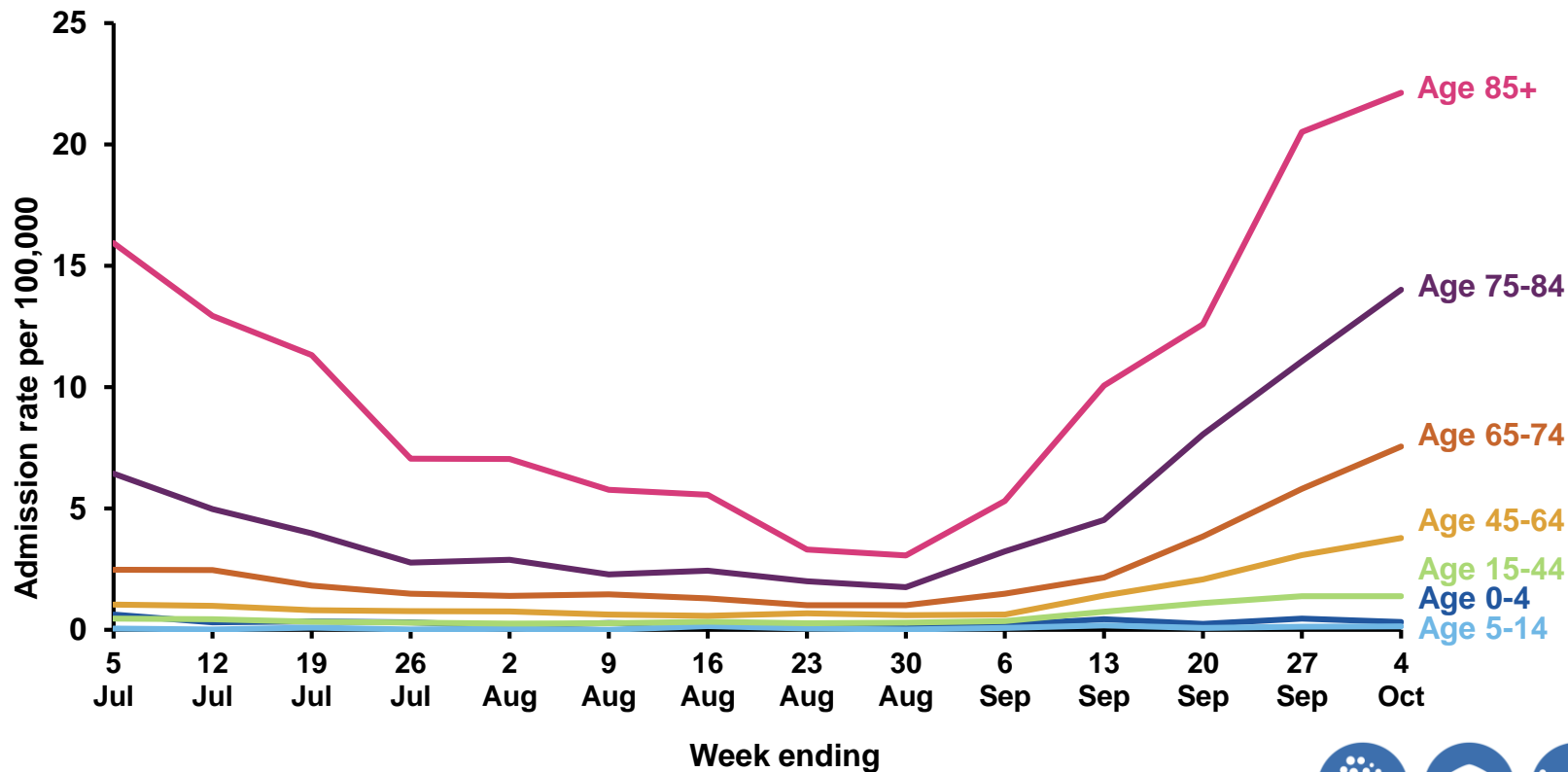


Estimate of weekly rate of new COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population in England by region and age group



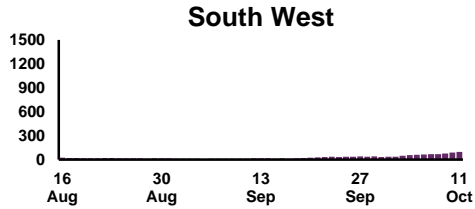
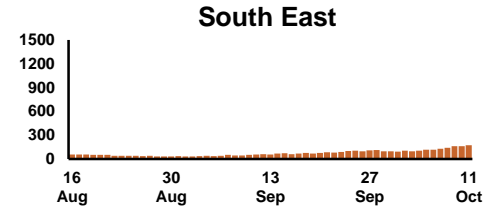
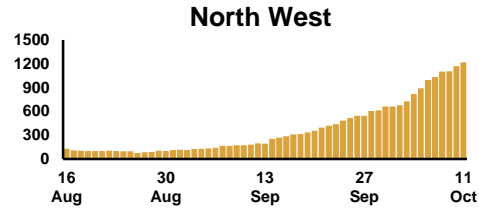
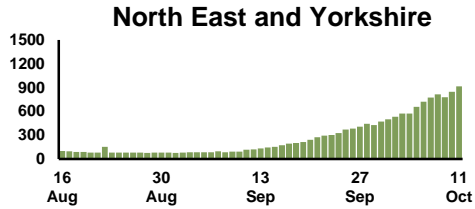
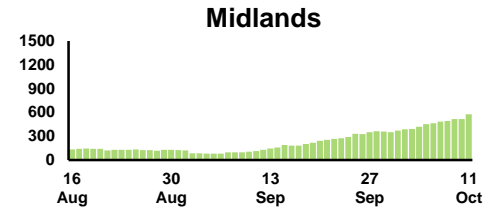
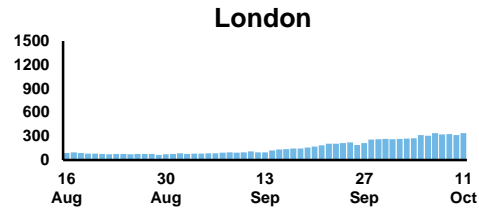
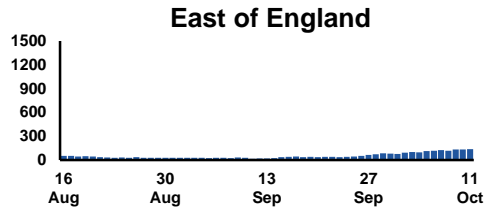
