

An estimated 224,400 people within the community population in England had COVID-19 from 25 September to 1 October.


This is around 1 in 240 people.







#### Geographical spread of COVID-19 in England












#### Geographical spread of COVID-19 in England (Ages 60+)



















### Estimate of weekly rate of new COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population in England by region and age group







#### Patients in hospital with COVID-19 in England by NHS region























# North West: COVID-19 hospital admissions (all ages) and weekly case rate in those 60 years and over
