JUDGMENT

- (2) I make a protective award in respect of the 3 claimants who were employees of the respondent at its premises at: Unit 10/11, Rolls Royce Industrial Estate, Spring Road, Wolverhampton, West Midlands, WV4 6JX and who were dismissed as redundant on 1 March 2019 and order the 1st respondent to pay the claimants remuneration for the protected period of 90 days beginning on 1 March 2019. I declare that each claimant is entitled to an award in respect of 90 days.
